Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad Introduces New Fall Flyer Train

Peninsula, Ohio – One of the best ways to see the vibrant colors of fall is by train! The Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad is introducing a new Fall Flyer excursion in October. This two-hour, nonstop train ride is a beautiful way to enjoy the changing leaves and scenery in Cuyahoga Valley National Park.

The train departs from Rockside station (Independence, OH) at 9:45 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays in October.

The train consist will have coach and dining car seating. Snacks, drinks and merchandise will be available for purchase in the concession car.

The Coach Ticket is \$20 and is valid for one round trip ticket in the coach cars. The Deluxe Ticket is \$25 and is valid for one round trip in the dining cars. Seats are in dining tables, at four tops.

All passengers ages 3 and over require a ticket. Passengers ages 2 and under do not require a ticket, but must sit on a parent's or guardian's lap.

Tickets can be purchased online or at the station 30 minutes prior to departure time.
