Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad Volunteers Set New Record

PENINSULA, OHIO, February 6, 2018 -- Volunteers at Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad (CVSR) contributed 104,221 hours in 2017, an increase of nearly 11,000 over 2016. More than 1,800 individual volunteers contributed their time and talents to CVSR during 2017.

Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad is a nonprofit organization that relies entirely on the support of volunteers. CVSR volunteers serve many roles on and off the train each year, including: trainmen, concessionaires, conductors, brakemen, servers, and special event attendants, and support programs such as Day Out with Thomas and The Polar Express. Many have led their own initiatives in creating safety and preservation committees.

"We would like to take this opportunity to thank our volunteers," said President & CEO Joe Mazur. "Their support has enabled us to run successful train excursions that brought more than 213,000 passengers into the national park this past year."
