Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad (CVSR) announced today that Grape Escape, featuring wines from Gervasi Vineyard, is sold out for Saturday, June 8. This is the second year the event has sold out.

CVSR partnered with Gervasi Vineyard last year to give guests an opportunity to taste their wines aboard a Grape Escape wine tasting excursion. Due to the popularity of the event in 2018, the partnership continued in 2019.
